To actively pursue your hockey development at the AAA Midget Hockey Level is a significant decision for many young hockey players. There are many implications to such a decision.

Our season officially begins with our training camp in August. This year our **training camp begins on Friday Aug 26th and runs until Sunday Aug 28th after the Blue and White Inter squad game.** Due to the uncertainty surrounding the current mail strike, registration fees are set at \$80.00 if you register prior to August 1st, and \$120.00 for registrations after August 1st. **It is important to remember the tryout fee is nonrefundable.**

The Norman Northstars organization has a strong commitment to combining education with hockey. Because of this, it is important for potential players to join the organization wanting to do their very best in both hockey and high school.

For those players living outside of Thompson, if selected to play for the AAA Norman Northstars, we must work together to make your transition, as smooth as possible to the RD Parker Collegiate.

1. You **MUST** enclose a transcript of your marks with your registration thus giving us a basic knowledge of your academic history, no exceptions.
2. You and your parents will then meet with an R.D. Parker representative and the Northstars' Education Chairperson to set up a course of study for both the first and second semesters. **IF WE DO NOT HAVE A TRANSCRIPT AND / OR A COPY OF YOUR LAST REPORT CARD AT THE TRAINING CAMP YOU CANNOT BE REGISTERED IN SCHOOL.**

If selected as a player it is important to know that you will be viewed as a role model in the community and the Northstar Organization expects all players to demonstrate hard work, respect and dedication to the team and community both on and off the ice.

The north produces many good hockey players. The best players in the north come to training camp, so please remember to show up with the proper attitude, in good physical shape, work hard and show the coaching staff what you have to offer.

To the returning players you must also remember to present to camp prepared to work hard and in good physical shape as you will be looked upon as the leaders and role models.
